If you are arriving by train or by coach from Stansted airport, we suggest you take a short taxi ride to the college.

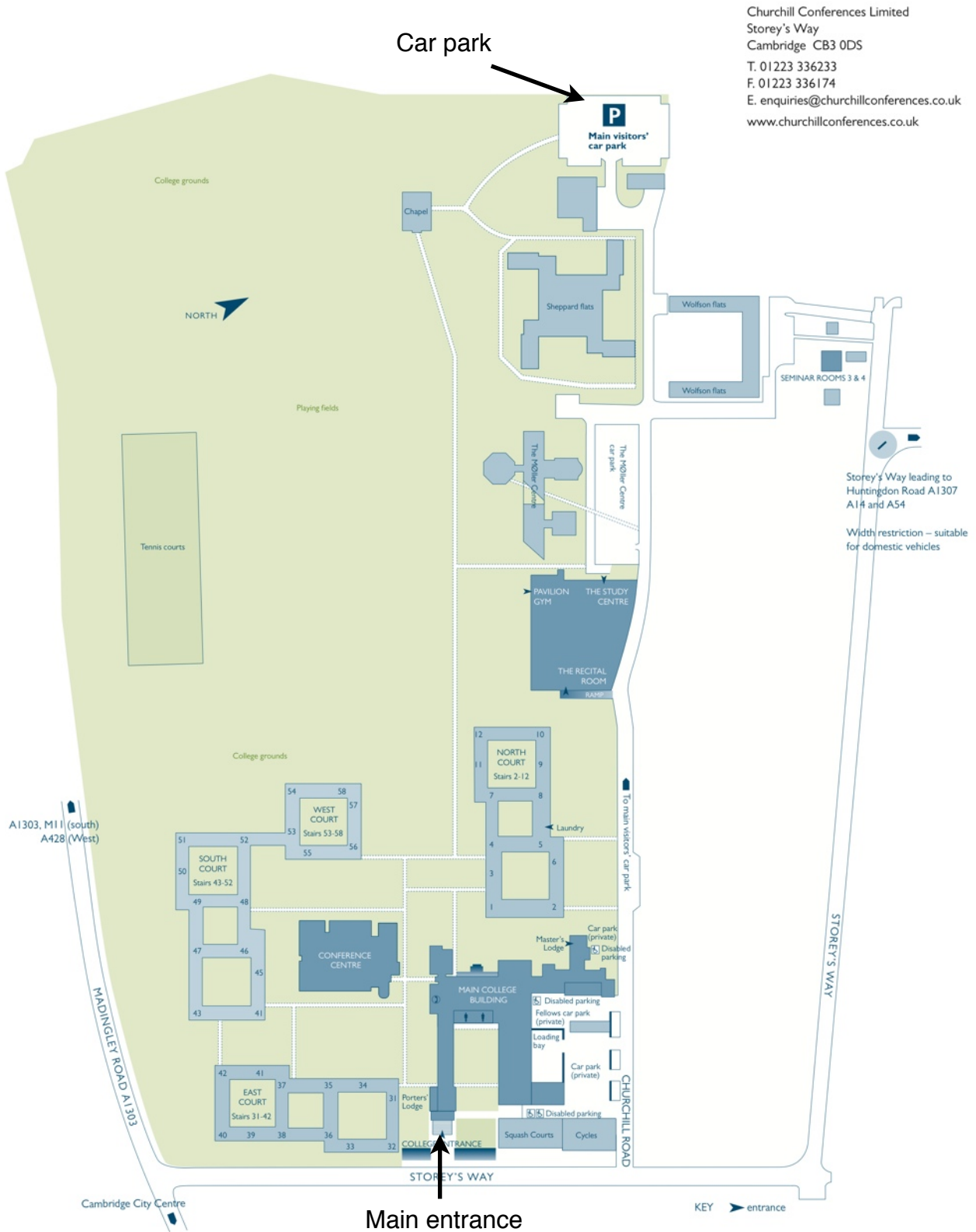
There is a taxi rank opposite the train station entrance with a plentiful supply of taxis, so no need to book.

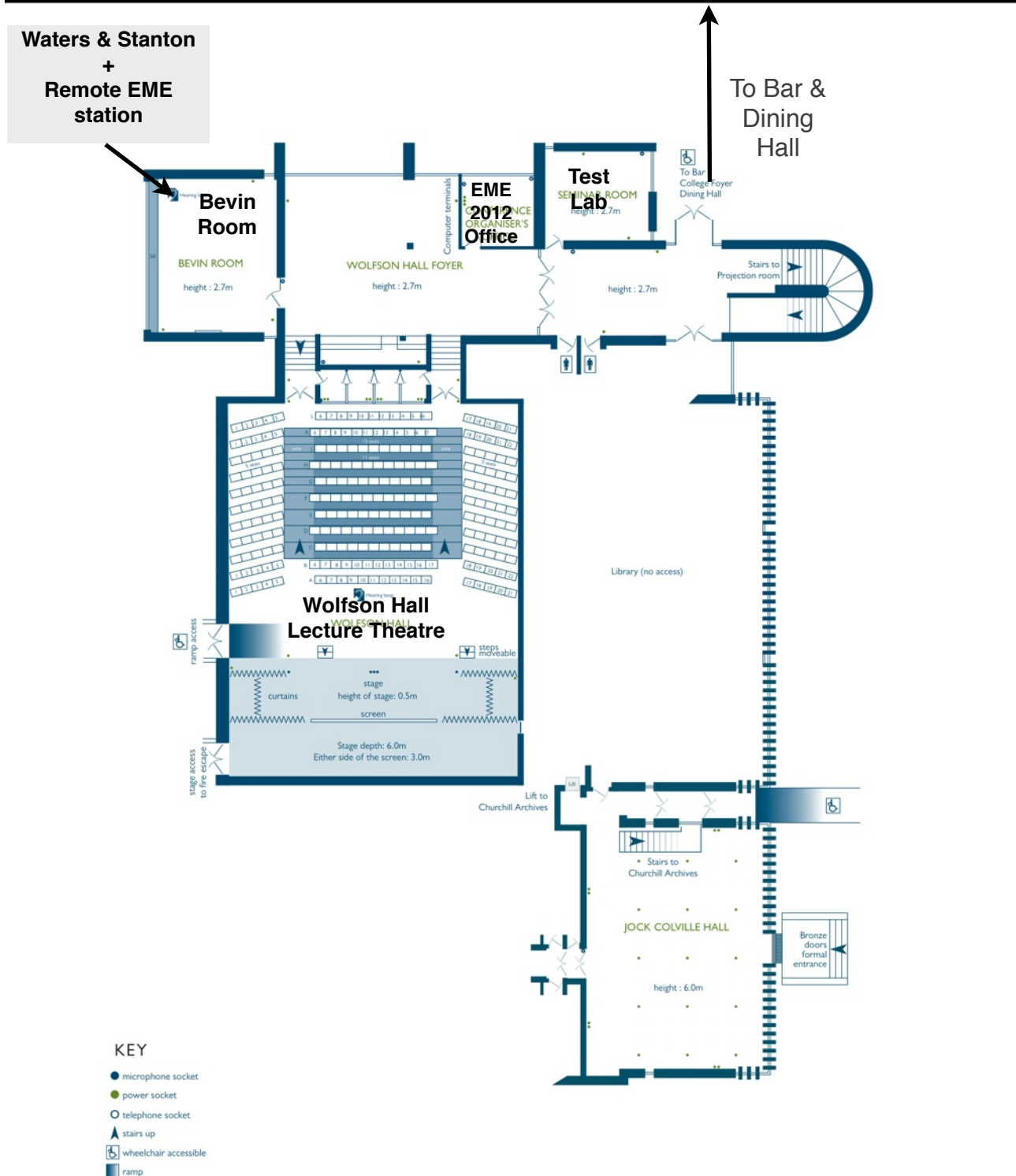

Accommodation booked at the College will not be available for occupancy earlier than 14.00 hours on the day of arrival.

Breakfast and other meals

IT and Electrics

Mains supply

In the UK we have 240V 50Hz supply; you may require an adaptor for your existing plugs.

Internet Access

There is free WiFi access in the public areas. Each bed room has a RJ45 outlet and will require a CAT5 cable. NB there is a download limit of 500MB/day per MAC address so please don't plan on using iPlayer and the like for catching up on your favourite TV programme.

Some visitors' non-European phones may not roam/work on 3G as the frequency bands are different.

On-site server

Once you are connected to the college network an EME Conference file server will also be available. You can access this using your favourite file manager/app (fileshare path \\eme2012\public). You may use it to share photos. More details are available from EME2012 Reception.

Fire
